


Experience Management


Language Fallback

Keep an eye on the performance cost!






Detection Services // IP Geo-Location

Detection Services // Device Detection


Allows personalisation on over 650 device capabilities.

Campaign Creation Tool




Marketing Taxonomy

Introduced in 8.0

Additional support in 8.1 throughout the platform

Taxonomies

- Campaign Group
 - Group campaign activities for cross personalization and tracking
- Venue
 - Location based tracking and personalization
- Channel
 - Tracking and personalization on campaign or interaction channels
- Asset
 - Classification and tracking of media assets
- Outcome groups
 - Groups outcomes and allows analytics across.
- Also supports custom facets






React on Historic Data: Key Behavior Cache

Rules and conditions can specify if a marketing activity such as campaign or goal was triggered, not just the current session but previous visits as well.

Rules Supports:

- Campaigns
- Channels
- Goals
- Outcomes
- PageEvents
- Venues

Supports custom values through API






Contact Behavior Profile

A visitor's behavior profile from their previous visit can now influence personalization rules in their current and future visit.

Behavior Profiling are now stored both on the Interaction and Contact.

Behavior Profile on the Contact can decay at a given rate per interaction.







Content Testing


Two KPIs added to each rule in the dialog

- Effect measures how the rule improves Engagement Value based on past tests
- Reach measures the percentage of site visitors that have seen the rule

Ability to Cancel Tests

Better logic for tests on multiple languages and devices

- Allow users to run individual tests on the same page in different languages
- Test of content changes are now across devices, as the page items content is shared between devices
- Better help and information to the users over these features






Experience Editor // Versions and Layouts

Ability to toggle between and edit different versions in the Experience Editor.






Experience Editor // Validation






